

AUBURN YEAR ROUND 6 K WALK  
WALK DIRECTIONS

1. Leaving the Start Point, look for the bank and Starbucks across the parking lot and slightly left. Carefully walk across the parking lot toward the the Bank and Starbucks. BE CAREFUL. Turn LEFT and find the stairway going down to Elm Ave. Go down the stairway to Elm Ave. *There are several businesses that have restrooms: Albertson's, Starbucks, etc.*
  2. Turn RIGHT and proceed to the stop light at Hiway 49. Cross Hiway 49 on the WALK signal.
  3. Turn RIGHT as soon as you cross Hiway 49 and follow a paved path that parallels Hiway 49. Follow this trail past KINKO'S and other businesses.
  4. Just past the stores (and before entering the school grounds), there is a road going up the hill to the left past H&R Block.
  5. Turn left and follow this road up the hill. There will be a dirt path ahead of you with yellow posts. Go around the posts and walk slightly right and ahead on a concrete walk toward the front of the Library building. This is the Auburn-Placer County Library.
  6. Walk in front of the Library and turn left down Library Rd toward Nevada St. Turn LEFT on Nevada St. and continue down Nevada St. to the traffic light at Fulweiler Ave/Blocker Dr.
  7. Cross Nevada St. at the light and follow Blocker Dr. to the Amtrak Station. *There are restrooms and a drinking fountain at the station.* Return to Nevada St.
  8. Cross Nevada St, staying on the left side of Fulweiler Ave. About 100 yards up the street on the right is the entrance to the old Auburn Cemetery.  
*If you have some time and are interested in exploring old cemeteries, carefully cross (no crosswalk) Fulweiler Ave, and enter the cemetery. This is a good cemetery to explore. If you turn left after entering the cemetery and follow the fence line almost to the side boundary fence, you will see the grave of Rattlesnake Dick, an infamous outlaw. You will exit the cemetery by the same gate that you entered it. Carefully cross Fulweiler Ave. and turn right.*
  9. Continue on Fulweiler Ave to Carson Ave on the right. Turn RIGHT and CAREFULLY CROSS Fulweiler Ave (no crosswalk) and follow Carson Ave. It will make a sharp left bend and become Chana Dr. Follow Chana Dr to the right down towards Hiway 49. Just before Hiway 49 turn RIGHT on an unmarked frontage road. Follow the frontage road around a right curve and up the hill (becomes Sawyer St.).
  10. Stay on Sawyer St. up and over the hill to Chamberlain Ave.
  11. Turn LEFT on Chamberlain Ave and follow it down to Placer St.
  12. Cross Placer St. and turn RIGHT. Continue on this road. When you come to the Freeway over-crossing, turn LEFT and cross the freeway.
  13. When you are across the freeway turn LEFT (this is Maple St) and proceed to the closest crosswalk. Cross Maple St and turn LEFT. The historic COURTHOUSE is on your right. At the corner of Maple St/Lincoln Way/Auburn Folsom Rd, turn RIGHT into the Courthouse parking lot and enter the Courthouse. THERE IS A SECURITY GUARD INSIDE THE DOOR. The Placer County Museum is on the first floor. *(The museum qualifies this walk as a California's Golden Heritage event. If the Courthouse is closed, you can still count the event.)*
- CHECKPOINT QUESTION: *What are the hours of the museum? Write answer on your start card/envelope.*
14. Exit the Courthouse and return to parking lot entrance. Turn RIGHT on Lincoln Way and follow for one short block to Court St.
  15. Turn RIGHT on Court St and follow it to end of block. This is Commercial St (possibly no sign).
  16. Turn LEFT and go down the stairs to

Lincoln Way. *Straight ahead of you is the Historic Firehouse. This is Old Town, another nice place to explore. There are public restrooms here next to the Firehouse.*


17. Turn LEFT on Lincoln Way and proceed to the next corner. Station A, of the U.S. Post Office, is located across Lincoln Way at the corner. *It is the oldest continuously operated Post Office in the western United States.*
18. Lincoln Way goes around the corner to the left. Cross Lincoln Way at the corner. Continue up Lincoln Way on the left side of the street. You will pass the Courthouse.
19. At the intersection of Maple St, Lincoln Way and Auburn Folsom Rd, turn RIGHT on Auburn Folsom Rd.
20. Watch for entrance to School Preserve Park. Turn LEFT to enter park. (*Qualifies*

*as WPA Project.*) Follow path through and to the left to exit to Lincoln Way. On the left as you approach Lincoln Way is the Police Department and Civic Center. (*Qualifies as Honoring Law Enforcement.*)

21. Turn RIGHT on Lincoln and follow Lincoln Way. *On the LEFT at the corner of Lincoln Way and Pine St is Paula's Bakery which qualifies for the Bakeries Program).*
22. Continue on Lincoln Way to the Cinema on the right just past Almond. (*Qualifies for Classic Cinemas Program.*)
23. Continue on Lincoln Way to first crosswalk. Carefully cross Lincoln Way and turn LEFT. Return to Almond St.
24. Turn RIGHT on Almond. (*Carnegie Library is part way up the hill on the left and qualifies for Carnegie Libraries Program.*)

26. At top of hill turn RIGHT on E. Placer St and follow it down to High St.
27. Cross High St. and walk slightly right

2. Continue on Elm St., to light opposite the Center.
3. Cross the freeway off ramp and turn right



toward the Clock Tower. (This is a tricky area.) At the Clock tower go LEFT up Lincoln Way, on the RIGHT SIDE of the road.

28. Walk up Lincoln Way. When you get to the hotel building, look to the RIGHT to find the large mural on the end of the building facing the hotel. (This qualifies for the Murals Program.)

1. Continue up Lincoln Way to Elm Ave. Coolie statue will be on the right just before Elm St.

to cross Elm St. Stay straight ahead to enter shopping center. Flour Garden Bakery will be on the right in the first building past the Wells Fargo Bank building.
