START/FINISH: Main parking lot, behind Fallon House, on Columbia St. Columbia is on Parrots Ferry Road, accessed from CA HWY 49, between Angels Camp (14 miles) and Sonora (3 miles), CA. See map.

REGISTRATION: 8:30 AM

START TIME: 9:00 AM

FINISH TIME: No later than 1:00 PM

TRAIL & DETAILS: The 10 km walk is rated 2B. You will walk through historic downtown, a residential area, and out to the general aviation airport and the CalFire Air Attach operation; mostly on paved streets, with some dirt paths, and a short section through a rougher un-graded section (dry creek bed). No wheelchairs or strollers. Pets on leash with cleanup allowed.

Columbia is a gold rush town, a living town authentically restored. Many museums and exhibits to see; take a stagecoach ride; pan for gold. Good lodging and camping within five miles.

This is a MONDAY event, put on by special request from the *Tuolumne County Visitor's Bureau* and the *Outdoor Writers Association of California*. Come and help us showcase AVA/CVA to this special group.

**PRE-REGISTRATION:** Please pre-register by September 9, 2013. If walking for IVV/AVA credit, make checks for \$3.00 per person payable to: *Sierra Gold Striders*; complete the registration form; mail to PO Box 1253, Twain Harte, CA - 95383. There will be no refunds for pre-registration.

**SERVICES:** Water and restrooms are available at the Start/Finish and along the route. There are several excellent restaurants in the immediate area.
